Your GDPR form yet?*

Due to a change in the Law last May in the area of Data Protection, we are now required to obtain your permission to keep your data.

- **What data do we keep at St Donard's?**

If you are a member of St Donard's church the data we are likely to hold on you is ...

Your name and address, telephone number, email address, date of birth. If you give financially we will have information relating to Standing Orders and Gift Aid if you have signed a Gift Aid form in the past.

- **What do you have to do?**

You must give us permission to hold this data by signing the yellow GDPR form and return it either to the RECTOR or GDPR Coordinator, Caroline Fox

- **What happens if I don't sign the form?**

If you don't sign the form and return it to us – it means you are not giving your permission for us to have your information. This means that under the Law we will not be able to keep you on our parish list, you will no longer receive a CONTACT Magazine or any contact from the church.

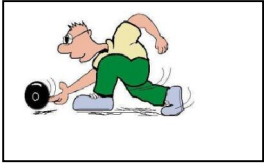

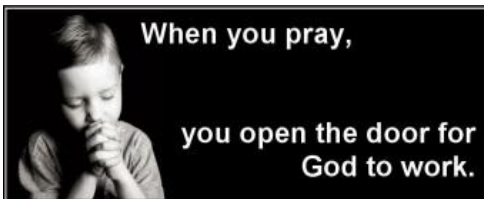
